WHY JOIN A SNOWSPORTS CLUB?

Bristol Mountain Snowsports Clubs are the best way for students to get outside, be active, hang out with their friends (or make new ones!), and have fun during the winter months.

Club Memberships

Memberships are sold to students in 4th grade and at least 8 years old.

This pass is valid every week on the night chosen from the start of our Twilight Season (tentatively scheduled on December 13) through March 8. You can come weeks when your Snowsports Club isn't scheduled to visit.

Equipment and Rentals

- Four-or-Six-Time Rental Options
 - Ski Rentals include; skis, boots and poles
 - Snowboard Rentals include; snowboard and boots

****Helmets are not included** and can be rented individually. Students will also have access to purchase steeply discounted helmets through the ecommerce store.*

****A \$10 fee is charged for equipment that is not returned to the Rental Shop at the end of every evening.**

PERSONAL SECURITY

Ski and snowboard racks are located around the lodges and base area. It is strongly recommended that students secure personal equipment in the racks.

LESSONS

- Lesson packages include four 1-hour classes
- Lesson dates: Jan 2 – Jan 29, with a makeup week of Feb 3 – Feb 9
- Lessons are available for both students and parents. 1-hour parent lessons will be held at the same times and the same groups as student lessons
- There will be no lessons after Feb 9th
- The Snowsports Meeting Place is located in between the Sunset and Comet Express chairlifts

WHAT TO BRING TO SNOWSPORTS CLUB

- Snowsports equipment, unless picking up rentals from the Rental Shop
- Winter clothes; layer up starting with a base layer top and bottom, ski/snow pants, ski/snow jacket, face mask/buff/neck gaiter, ski/snow socks, warm/waterproof gloves, snow goggles
- Food; bags can be kept in the lodge at the Snowsports club designated table, food can be purchased at Carver's Kitchen in upper Rocket Lodge
- If your student is purchasing food, money can be loaded onto their gateway card (ski pass), a fingerprint can be uploaded and attached to their account for purchases, gift cards can be purchased or make sure they have cash or a card.
